

Eagle River Road - MP 5.3 to 12.6

DOT&PF Project No. STP-0550(15)/53943

The Eagle River Road Project is a Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation project to extend the service life of the road and enhance both safety and capacity.

In order to accommodate the shoulders and widened road surface, land will be acquired from several parcels. A portion of this area, approximately 10.6 acres is located in the Chugach State Park, a Section 4(f)/6(f) property. We believe the addition of shoulders in combination with the turn-around at the Eagle River Nature Center will improve access to the park. We are currently working on documentation to fulfill the Section 4(f)/6(f) requirements and welcome public comments.
